



Problems The User perspective

- Engagement Why should I come to the website?
- Posting confusion blogs, local news sites, forums, comments.
 Where do I post what?
- Conversations build ad-hoc within forums or as comments to blog posts. How do I find the active conversations in my area?
- How do I discover the conversations that happen in the wild, i.e., via blogs and cross-linking?
- Taxonomy Where does a post belong?

Problems Design perspective

- The problem of **relevance**: Local news and online discussion is difficult to find. Automatic aggregation of news sites isn't always relevant in the local context.
- The problem of scale: Web 2.0 sites are driven by thousands or millions of users constantly creating, tagging, rating and recommending content - Local websites have ~10-100 users, many of them occasional or one-time users.

Prototype

- Models on how communication occurs on the web around topics rather than groups.
- Multiple input and output points: Web, Email, SMS, Phone Call.
- Doesn't go stale: system-generated stories keep the site 'fresh'
- Utilizes activity streams and system-generated stories to instigate conversation
